Giant River Otter Search

This is a morning activity that requires an early start (as soon as we start we have a better chance of seeing more wildlife). To get there, we have to walk to the river to take the boat and take a 15 minute boat ride upstream, then walk for 25 to 30 minutes to get to the lake. Once there, we will paddle in a comfortable catamaran in search of all kinds of wildlife and, of course, the family of giant river otters is our main target.

This place itself is beautiful and is home to different species of wildlife such as the black caiman, many types of birds and monkeys such as squirrel monkeys.

Located 5 minutes down river by boat, we will visit the local farm. When traveling, the best way to learn more about the locals is through their market. Here it will be their local farms. You will be able to see and taste various tropical fruits and learn about all the variety of crops grown by the local people.

Our host will show you the local techniques for agriculture and you will get a better understanding of one of the main economic activities of the region.

For this activity, we will walk from the lodge for approximately 2 hours through a pristine forest passing through two different types of forest (terra firme and flooded forest) with great possibilities to look for some wildlife.

At the end a huge Ceiba (Lupuna) awaits us, towering above the forest.

We will go down the river for 15 minutes to the Native Community of Infierno of the Ese'Eja ethnic group who have a Medicinal Center; where they heal their people using local medicine; which is still part of their knowledge inherited from their ancestors, nowadays in combination with western medicine.

While we are on the river, we could look for more wildlife, such as the well-known ronsoco, considered the largest rodent on the planet.

This hike is a beautiful ancient patch of Brazil nut forest that has been harvested for decades (if not centuries) where you can still experience the remnants of a camp used two months a year by Brazil nut gatherers. We will demonstrate the entire process of the only sustainably harvested product of the rainforest, from harvesting to transportation, drying and the products we consume. And as an added bonus, this hike around the forest allows you another opportunity to see more wildlife.

For this activity, we walk about 2 hours round trip.



Just a 15 to 20 minute walk from the lodge to the river bank, we will find a hide where we will wait for the bird to gather in the trees and eventually land on the bank to eat clay. Scientists don't know exactly why parrots do this, but suspect it has to do with mineral deficiencies.

Different types of wildlife feed on sagebrush, such as Spix's guans, howler monkeys, and peccaries.

A visit to the Canopy tower gives you the opportunity to have a full view of the vast rainforest from up in the trees; and at the same time offers you the chance to spot wildlife depending on the time of day, weather conditions and luck. and luck. It is also a great place to enjoy watching the suprise and

To get there, we have to walk about 20 minutes through a pristine forest with great opportunities to encounter amazing wildlife such as monkeys, birds, colorful and cute insects, etc. The tower itself is a 40 mts. or 131 ft. metal scaffolding tower with easy steps to walk to the top.

After walking away from the Tambopata River, past the hanging nests of Oropendola birds and fluttering fruit bats, you arrive at the lake. Separated by only a thin strip of land from the river, this lake is a world away from those torrential waters. Here, tranquility reigns. But the lake's calm waters and beautiful scenery belie the wild creatures, from small to giant, that lurk just below the surface.

On a visit to the lake, you will experience one of the Amazon's most important and distinctive habitats. They are formed when the meander of a river separates from its main channel, transforming it into a tranquil lake.
